## PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The **Master of Internal Medicine** is a four-year postgraduate training programme designed to equip physicians with the knowledge, clinical skills, and professional values required to provide safe, effective, and person-centred care. The programme offers broad-based exposure to the generality of internal medicine, complemented by structured rotations in major subspecialties, ensuring graduates develop into skilled diagnosticians and holistic clinicians capable of managing complex multimorbidity in diverse healthcare settings.

Training is delivered across UiTM's teaching hospitals and affiliated centres, combining evidence-based clinical practice, academic learning, and multidisciplinary collaboration. The programme emphasises not only clinical competence but also professionalism, research, and leadership, preparing graduates to contribute to advancing internal medicine in Malaysia. Upon completion, trainees will be well-prepared for independent practice in tertiary centres, district hospitals, or rural facilities, and to serve as future leaders in clinical care, research, and medical education.

## PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

1. Deliver effective, person-centred and value-based care by applying evidence, informed medical knowledge and clinical skills to problem solve, manage and coordinate care.
2. Demonstrate ethical conduct, professionalism, and commitment towards personal development and lifelong learning.
3. Be leaders in the field and contribute to education, research and the promotion of health in the local, national and international settings.

## PROGRAMME LEARNING OUTCOMES

1. To demonstrate comprehensive knowledge in the field of internal medicine and sufficient in its subspecialties.
2. To recognise, analyse critically, evaluate and resolve problems related to internal medicine based on evidence-based practice.
3. To demonstrate clinical competency in the management and decision making the field of internal medicine.
4. To demonstrate social accountability and act as a consultant to enhance the level of expertise, practice and standards of internal medicine services.
5. To demonstrate effective communication with family members, professional colleagues and allied health personnel.
6. To master technical skills and use of information technology in facilitating discussions and communication with patients and family members.
7. To demonstrate capability to carry out research activities in the field of internal medicine.
8. To demonstrate leadership in internal medicine services by managing information efficiently and with the ability for continuous education to enhance the level of expertise and to keep up with the latest developments in medicine.
9. To manage internal medicine services and identify entrepreneurial opportunities.
10. To demonstrate a high level of professionalism, values, attitudes, responsibilities and ethical conduct in providing holistic management in the practice of internal medicine.

# PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

**Stage 1  
(Year 1)**      **GENERAL MEDICINE ROTATION**  
Trainees will be doing 1 year of general medicine rotation and develop core clinical competencies under close supervision.

**Stage 2  
(Year 2 and 3)**      **SUBSPECIALITY ROTATION**  
Trainees undergo subspeciality rotation namely Cardiology, Respiratory, Gastroenterology, Nephrology, Neurology, Endocrinology, Infectious Disease. Haematology, Rheumatology, Geriatric and Palliative Care.

**INTERNAL MEDICINE QUALIFYING ASSESSMENT EXAMINATION (THEORY AND CLINICAL)**

**Stage 3  
(Year 4)**      **RESEARCH AND GENERAL MEDICINE**  
Trainees will consolidate their expertise in general medicine or an approved subspecialty and act as a Registrar.

\*\*Continuous assessments are conducted throughout the program using methods such as work-place based assessments and logbook.



# ENTRY REQUIREMENT

## General Requirements

1. Have a recognized medical degree (MBBS/MD or equivalent qualification)
2. Pass the Internal Medicine entrance examination or passed Part 1 MRCP examination
3. Meet additional requirement(s) set by the Universiti Teknologi MARA

## Additional requirement for Malaysian candidates:

- Have the Full Registration certificate with a valid Annual Practising certificate (APC)

## Additional requirement for non-Malaysian candidates:

- Have the Temporary Practising Certificate (TPC) from the Malaysian Medical Council
- Must have achieved an acceptable level of English competency as set by the University
