INTRODUCTION OF PROGRAMME

THE POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMME (MD 773)

The Master of Medicine (Family Medicine) MD773 programme started in the Faculty of Medicine, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) in 2010. The first intake was in June 2011 with three students. Since then, the programme has expanded to provide high-quality primary care training and services which has been accredited by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA). The general objective of this programme is to provide in-depth training to doctors who will become Family Medicine Specialists to meet the demand of our fast-developing nation. The training includes acute and chronic care, maternal and child health as well as specialist community health care needs such as geriatric, adolescent and community mental health clinics.

PROGRAMME DURATION

The mode of this programme is clinical coursework with a component of research activity which will comprise of about 30 % of the whole programme. The minimum duration of study is FOUR (4) years. The maximum duration of study is SEVEN (7) years.

- Family Medicine Specialists who are knowledgeable, competent, and able to practice independently using evidencebased medicine.
- Family Medicine Specialists who are highly motivated, competent, and patient-centered with leadership skills to lead the profession.

- 5) Demonstrate effective patient-centered communication skills.

- 7) Exhibit good leadership skills and responsibility.
- 8) Integrate effective personal skills.
- 9) Demonstrate entrepreneurial skills.
- 10) Use quantitative and qualitative data.
- 11) Demonstrate ethical consideration and professionalism.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS THE APPLICATION **PROCESS**

Candidates must:

- Possess a degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery or an equivalent medical qualification approved by the UiTM Senate.
- Possess a full registration with the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC).
- Have completed at least 1 year of post-registration clinical experience as approved by the UiTM senate.
- Pass the entrance evaluation which consists of an interview, or any form of assessment deemed necessary by the Discipline/Department responsible and the Faculty of Medicine.

Ministry of Health (MOH) Candidates

- i. Please refer to MOH for application for Master programme.
- ii. Sit for the pre-requisite entrance examination, i.e Medical Specialist Pre-entrance Examination (MedEX)
- iii. Attend an entrance interview by Family Medicine Specialty Committee and Ministry of Health

Private Candidates or Trainee Lecturer

- i. Contact the Head of Department, Primary Care Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, UiTM
- ii. Apply via Universiti Teknologi MARA (Sungai Buloh campus) human resource (application form can be obtained from the Deanery's office)
- iii. Candidates may be asked to sit for the preentranceexamination, i.e Medical Specialist Pre-entrance Examination (MedEX)
- iv. Candidates who are short-listed will be interviewed by the Faculty of Medicine, UiTM

(Candidates can apply at any time but the programme starts in June and the application process may take some time)
